Outcome 1

Install temporary electric fences.

Range components – temporary electric fence standards, reels, poly wire or tape.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Transport fence components without damage, or undue risk of damage, to materials.
- 1.2 Install fence components to land contours and manufacturer's specifications.
- 1.3 Fence wire is energized to same voltage as lead out line without shorting and tested using a digital voltmeter.

Outcome 2

Dismantle temporary electric fences and store components.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Dismantle fences without damage, or undue risk of damage, to materials.

- 2.2 Store fence components without damage, or undue risk of damage, to materials.
