Describe methods of shearing sheep and preparing wool for sale.

- 2.1 Describe preparation and care of sheep in relation to procedures before, during, and after shearing.
- 2.2 Describe shearing shed procedures and methods.
 - Range procedures include but are not limited to sheep care, wool quality.
- 2.3 Describe classing of fleece wool in terms of the procedures in relation to end use.

Range fleece wool includes but are not limited to – strong wools, midmicron, fine wools or merino.

2.4 Describe clip preparation methods in relation to the major wool types and the factors influencing preparation.

Range factors include but are not limited to – length, colour, strength, vegetable matter, micron.

2.5 Describe factors influencing the prices paid for wool in terms of those able to be influenced by the grower.

Range factors before, during, and after shearing.

Outcome 3

Describe the sale of wool in New Zealand.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Describe a grower's clip in terms of the handling sequence from farm gate to sale and payment.
- 3.2 Describe outlets for the sale of wool in terms of their systems of handling and selling the wool.
