Outcome 2

Identify parties affected by infrastructure worksite activities.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Parties directly affected by infrastructure worksite activities are identified.
 - Range may include but is not limited to shops, businesses, schools, adjoining landowners, adjacent households, pedestrians, cyclists, motorists; evidence of four affected parties is required.
- 2.2 Other parties affected by infrastructure worksite activities are identified.
 - Range may include but is not limited to local authority, service authority, iwi, police, emergency services, event organisers, transport services; evidence of three other parties is required.

Outcome 3

Notify parties affected by infrastructure worksite activities.

Range two notifications.

Performance criteria

3.1 Notifications for members of the public are carried out in accordance with contract specifications.

- 3.2 Notifications for other parties are carried out in accordance with contract specifications.
 - Range may include but is not limited to local authority, service authority, iwi, police, emergency services, event organisers, transport services; evidence of three other parties is required.
