<b>Purpose</b>	People credited with this unit standard are able to: confirm notifiable work for an infrastructure worksite; confirm and carry out permit requirements on an infrastructure worksite; and report and document notifiable work.

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### Guidance Information

- 1 Evidence presented for assessment against this unit standard must be consistent with safe working practices and be in accordance with relevant legislative and industry requirements.
- 2 Legislation relevant to this unit standard includes: Health and Safety at Work Act 2015; and all subsequent amendments and replacements.
- 3 Definitions  
*Industry requirements* refer to relevant policies, processes, methodologies, industry codes of practice, site specific health and safety plans, standard operating procedures, site safety plans, quality plans, work plans, traffic management plans, contract work programmes, job safety analysis, safe work method statements, job instructions, manufacturer's requirements, contract specifications, manuals, procedural documents.  
*Technical instructions* mean the defined procedures for the method of carrying out the construction process.
- 4 It is recommended people achieve Unit 20869, *Demonstrate knowledge of notifiable works and work permits typical of infrastructure works sites*, or demonstrate equivalent knowledge and skills before being assessed against this unit standard.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Confirm notifiable work for an infrastructure worksite.

**Performance criteria**

1.1 Notifiable work requirements are confirmed.

**Outcome 2**

Confirm and carry out permit requirements on an infrastructure worksite.

**Performance criteria**

2.1 Permit requirements are confirmed.

2.2 Site is visually inspected to confirm the types of protection required.

2.3 Any additional requirements are reported and match site conditions.

2.4 Confirmation ensures that permit documentation has been obtained on site prior to commencing work.

2.5 All site personnel are briefed on specific requirements of permits.

2.6 Services and obstructions on site are identified.

2.7 Visual inspections are undertaken to confirm that instructions have been carried out.

**Outcome 3**

Report and document notifiable work.

**Performance criteria**

3.1 Notifiable work is reported.

3.2 Safety procedures are documented.

3.3 Actions and corrective actions are documented.
