<b>Purpose</b>	People credited with this unit standard are able to design a stone memorial, and prepare a three dimensional drawing of a stone memorial.

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### Outcomes and evidence requirements

#### Outcome 1

Design a stone memorial.

#### Evidence requirements

- 1.1 Client brief is established, and is confirmed in accordance with company requirements.  
  
Range site, material, style, size, special features, budget.
- 1.2 Design is prepared in accordance with client specifications.
- 1.3 Original artwork conforms with client specifications.
- 1.4 Design and artwork comply with NZS 4242 and cemetery bylaws.

**Outcome 2**

Prepare three-dimensional drawing of a stone memorial.

**Evidence requirements**

- 2.1 Drawing is prepared to scale.
- 2.2 Three-dimensional drawing provides details of finishes and features in accordance with specifications.
- 2.3 Proposed design is reworked in accordance with client specifications.
- 2.4 Finished design complies with NZS 4242 and cemetery bylaws.
