- 2 Definitions

Saddlery refers to saddle, bridle, and accessories such as crupper, martingale, summer cover, winter cover, and saddle cloth.

Stable procedures are the verbal or written instructions to staff on practices and policies required within a particular workplace.
- 3 For this unit standard, the practical assessment evidence must be provided in the context of a commercial business operation under normal working conditions.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Identify and disassemble saddlery.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify saddlery in terms of its parts and functions.
- 1.2 Disassemble or unbuckle saddlery into functional parts in accordance with stable procedures, to ensure that all parts are accessible and retrievable.

Outcome 2

Clean, reassemble, and store saddlery.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Remove superficial foreign matter using methods that do not damage equipment, and in accordance with stable procedures.
- Range may include but is not limited to – sweat, dirt, mud.
- 2.2 Clean saddlery using methods that leave material clean and supple, in accordance with stable procedures.
- 2.3 Check working parts and components for damage and treat with oil to ensure freedom of movement, in accordance with stable procedures.
- 2.4 Reassemble saddlery ready for use in accordance with stable procedures.
- 2.5 Store saddlery in accordance with stable procedures.
