1.3 Design a gymnastics grid enabling the improved movement of horse and rider.

Range balance, approach, stride, takeoff.

#### Outcome 2

Build a gymnastics grid.

## Performance criteria

2.1 Prepare grid with materials which encourage a horse to jump.

Range solid, visible, sound, safe for horse and rider.

- 2.2 Position obstacles with distances between which relate to the horse's stride and allow the horse to jump in rhythm.
- Use a combination of trotting poles and grid obstacles which allow the horse to jump in rhythm.

# Outcome 3

Assess and adjust the gymnastics grid to improve the horse's way of going.

# Performance criteria

- 3.1 Assess grid distances continually to ensure that it improves the horse's way of going.
- 3.2 Adjust grid distances as required to improve the horse's way of going.
