### Guidance Information

- 1 Definition  
*Workplace policies and procedures* refers to the documented procedures and policies providing guidelines of the tasks and activities carried out in the workplace. This typically includes relevant health and safety requirements to eliminate hazard/risk in the workplace.
- 2 All required equipment must be operated and maintained in accordance with workplace policies and procedures.
- 3 All work practices must meet recognised codes of practice and documented worksite health and safety procedures (where these exceed code) for personal, product, and worksite health and safety, and must meet the obligations required under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, Land Transport Act 1998, and Resource Management Act 1991, and any subsequent amendments.
- 4 Assessment for this unit standard must include evidence of two launches and two retrievals.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Prepare a trailer boat and associated equipment and facilities for launching and retrieval.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Launching and retrieving requirements are matched with boat characteristics.  
  

Range	requirements – launching site requirements and trailer requirements; boat characteristics – appendages, protrusions.

- 1.2 Boat is prepared for launching and retrieving without damage, and in a manner that will prevent damage during subsequent launching and retrieving.

Range launching – hull watertight, no visible damage to hull;  
retrieving – appendages retracted.

- 1.3 Boat and trailer equipment is checked as operational and meeting any regulatory requirements before launching and retrieving begin.

## Outcome 2

Launch and retrieve a trailer boat from the water.

### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Trailer is positioned so that the vehicle is recoverable and there is sufficient draught of water to land the boat or launch.
- 2.2 Boat is launched.
- 2.3 Boat is retrieved from the water.
- 2.4 The boat is positioned to central trailer so that there will be no damage on retrieval and subsequent re-launching.
- 2.5 Method of securing the boat to the trailer meets regulatory requirements for road transport.
