Guidance Information

- 1 This unit standard does not assess the manufacture of joinery or joinery components.
- 2 Definitions
Job specifications refers to the specification requirements of the job being undertaken.
Workplace policies and procedures refers to the documented procedures and policies providing guidelines of the tasks and activities carried out in the workplace. This typically includes relevant health and safety policies to manage risk in the workplace.
- 3 All work practice must meet recognised codes of practice and documented worksite health and safety procedures (where these exceed code) for personal, product, and worksite health and safety, and must meet the obligations required under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, Health and Safety in Employment Regulations 1995, Resource Management Act 1991, Hazardous Substances and New Organism Amendment Act 2015, and any subsequent amendments.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare for installation of exterior boat joinery, hatches, and components.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Fastenings and adhesives are selected in terms of hardware and substrate materials' compatibility, durability, and appearance, and in accordance with job specifications.
- 1.2 Installation position is located in accordance with job specifications, and boat integrity is maintained.

- 1.3 Any variation to the installation position is documented and reported in accordance with workplace policies and procedures.
- 1.4 Surfaces are prepared for installation in accordance with job specifications.

Outcome 2

Carry out the installation of exterior boat joinery, hatches, and components.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Opening and frame sizes are checked for accuracy in accordance with job specifications.
- 2.2 Joinery units are attached to the boat structure in accordance with job specifications.
- Range evidence of three installations is required.
- 2.3 Completed installations are checked and remedial action is taken if required to ensure job specifications are met.
